School Administration Report	<p>Fundraising Options</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School Division website option is easy and viable. Software company (school cash online software group). They take a small percentage (4%). Get tax receipt. • Can do cheques/cash but it would be too much to do regular tax receipts for school administration. • Transferring of funds back and forth between school and CSCC – unable to do so. For the school to send back to CSCC doesn't work as easily. Donations goes into the school-based money. The 2 accounts join at the end. The CSCC and St. Matthew school would combine monies and pay the school division who would buy the play structure. • Book Fair – last in-person book fair was in 2019 and they raised \$2000; this year total monies raised was \$4600. The school gets 60% back in scholastics products. • Education budget in the province that was reported at 2.5% is in actuality 0.07% after determining a number of different factors. Maintenance and renewal was cut by 9%. • 168 students registered in the fall at St. Matthew. Currently we are at 205. Since September 30th (funding cutoff date), the school division has grown by 414 kids. Many new students and families from other countries. • This summer; spending 1.5 million on the roof. 	Dan
